

- The reception times for each date are as follows.

- FOWA2023 participants' reception is located in front of the hall, Marunouchi Building Hall & Conference Square, Marunouchi Building 7F.

- The registration desk will read the QR code on your entry pass and check you in.
 After check-in, you will be given a name badge, which you are requested to wear around your neck.

- Enter your pre-registered email address and password to log in.
- If you forget your password, you can reset it yourself.
- *You will be asked to set your password the first time you access the site.
- *If you cannot find your email, please click here to enter the login page.









After logging in to EventHub, you can post questions on the 'Q&A' tab on the right-hand side of the screen

- (1) Click on the 'Q&A' tab on the right-hand side of the screen and click on 'Type your question' or 'Ask'.
- (2) Type your comment, enter your name in [Your name] and click [Send].
- (3) Your comment will be posted.










After logging in to EventHub, you can watch the live webcast from the screen.

- You can watch videos on the main page after logging in.
- To switch between Japanese and English-language transmission, use the [Other Videos] button to switch channels.







After logging in to EventHub, you can watch the archived transmission from the "Archives" section of the screen.

- Click on 'Archives' within the main page after logging in.
- Select the thumbnail of the archive video to watch the video.
- FOWA2023 Bureau will inform you separately about the distribution period of the archive.










After logging in to EventHub, you can select the relevant session from the 'Materials' tab and download the material.

- (1) After logging in, click on the tab 'Materials' in the screen.
- (2) Click on the session for which you want to download the material.
- (3) Click 'Download' for the relevant file.











After logging in to EventHub, you can download your receipt from the icon in the top right-hand corner of the screen.

- (1) After logging in, click your name in the top right-hand corner of the screen and click [My QR].
- (2) Click [View Receipt] in [My QR].
- (3) To print, right-click and select [Print]; to save as a PDF file, paste a screenshot of the screen into Word or similar and save in PDF format.
- *If you wish to change the address to your company/organization's name, please go to 'Edit Profile' and temporarily change the name in your registration information to your company/organization's name to retrieve your receipt. After retrieving the receipt, please change the registered information back to your own name.
- *The proviso will be fixed at "Ticket price".









FAQ

Q: Which devices and models can I use?

A: EventHub is essentially a web service and can be used on all computers, smartphones and tablets.

There is no need to download an app.

Available on web browsers, mobile phones, PCs and tablets.

Supported versions: Android version 5 +, iOS version 11 +

Supported browsers: Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Internet Explorer, Microsoft Edge latest version

Supported mailer systems: mailers conforming to HTML standard specifications

Q: I have not received any emails.

A: Please check that your registered address is correct. If it is correct, make sure that the email from EventHub is not in your spam or junk folder.

If it is in your folder, please add the domain permission for the "@eventhub.jp" email.

Especially if you are using a mobile phone company's email address, please add domain permissions

Q: What are the recommended environment requirements?

A: We recommend using Windows 7 or later or macOS Sierra (10.12.6) or later browsers and versions.

- ▼ Browsers capable of playing h.264 MP4 videos with the following HTML5 players.
- -Chrome 30 or later.
- -Firefox 27 or later.
- -Internet Explorer 11 or later.
- -Microsoft Edge
- -Safari 9 or later.

Please make sure to log in to EventHub beforehand to check that the video plays without any problems.

A guide video on how to use this event will be played. There is no audio.

You may not be able to watch Vimeo due to company security blocks, etc. If the screen is dark and you cannot see or hear anything, it is likely that the screen is blocked.

- *In that case, please take the following actions.
- -Please set the domain (.vimeo.com) permissions in your company's IT department.
- -Use a different network environment or mobile connection to watch the video on your PC, smartphone or tablet.



FAQ

Q: The video cannot be played. It is interrupted in the middle of the video.

A: Please try the followings.

- Depending on your viewing environment (computer, tablet or smartphone) and browser, the transmission may not start until you refresh the page or press the player's play button.
- If the delivery does not start at the delivery time, press the play button on the player on the page. If the delivery does not start after doing so, refresh the page and press the play button on the player.
- If you are in incognito mode or have set your cache to not be saved, you may experience problems viewing the video. Please refrain from watching in incognito mode and reset the cache settings.
- If you are experiencing viewing difficulties, you may find that lowering the quality setting of your player will stabilise viewing.
